

## Lost Arrow Archery Meeting Minutes 1-4-2012

The meeting was called to order by George Buckley at 7:18pm. The following were present; George Buckley, Bobbie Buckley, Steve Lamb, Tim Stevens, Jamie Underwood, Mosely Middleton, Ken Sabec, Chris Kegler, Brad Moore, Patrick Bishop and his son.

The treasury report bank balance is \$31,000 which includes the grant money balance of \$9200 for the use of the target butts for the mountain range. The 9 target sponsors and all the major target sponsors have been paid for the 2012 shoots.

The last Vegas 450 shoot is Jan 15<sup>th</sup>. There has been an average of 14 shooters at each tournament. Due to low participation in the league shoots at Stuckenoffs, there will be another email sent out to people.

Stuckenoff's has requested that during any of the shoots that held at their facility, there be a sign in sheet that will be available.

Ken Sabec will be running two 10 night Handicap League at Stuckenoffs on Tuesdays and Thursdays, starting on Jan. 10, 6:30 pm. There was a review of the rules that will be implemented, they will be posted on the website and emailed to participants.

The Club is in need of artificial trees for the 3D shoots and for use at Stuckenoffs. If anyone is willing to donate or knows someone that has a sale on them, please feel free to contact one of the officers. Preferably without lights.

The 3D preparations were reviewed. Brad Moore has confirmed that the red numbers for the Traditional shooters and Youth will be completed and ready in the next couple weeks. The t-shirts are also ready at this time. The Senior class and the rules will be added to the scorecards. The overall awards for the Triple Crown will be buckles for 2012. The Fremont Motors logo will be added to the LAA target trailer. This is due to them becoming one of our major sponsors. There will be a need for someone with a diesel truck to help in taking the target trailer up the mountain for the summer shoots, as the person that has helped in the past will not be able to.

There is still discussion about what Organization the club would like to donate to. If anyone has any preference in this area, please speak up and let the officers know what you would like. At this time Wounded Warriors has been voiced about the most.

The raffle tickets will include Herb Meland bow, a bow from Rocky Mountain Sports and a Youth Women's bow from LC Bishop.

Patrick Bishop and his son were at the meeting to ask for help in their fund raising for Boy Scout Troop 235 in Casper. They would like to promote an additional archery shoot of 15-20 targets using the archery site on Casper Mountain. They are going to sell tickets for a raffle. The discussion was for a weekend shoot in August. The date will be announced with all the information at the 1<sup>st</sup> Leg of the Triple Crown Shoot. The proceeds from this shoot and raffle will go directly to them.
